These stories will review the sight words introduced in kindergarten this year, and will also introduce your child to new sight words. We recommend having your child read each book repeatedly to improve fluency and comprehension. The books are on a first grade reading level. The titles in bold are the easiest to read and we recommend having your child practice those books first. **Also, remember to read aloud to your child on a daily basis.**
